Coats, Bags and Accessories

Hartshill Academy Bag – provided to all Year 7s on the first day

Uniform Don'ts

No skinny fit trousers, jeans, leggings or fitted skirts.

Black tailored trousers. No skin tight material. Trousers should be smart and business like.

Trousers should cover the ankle.



No trainers, pumps, high heels or canvas shoes.

No fashion hoodies

No cotton leggings to be worn in PE; sports leggings only.

No skirts more than 1 inch above the knee

No rings, bracelets or necklaces

No false eyelashes

No facial or body piercing

No nail varnish or excessive and impractical length nails

No acrylic nails

Earphones or earpods should not be worn on the Academy site

No tattoos. It is illegal for children under the age of 18 to have a tattoo even with parental consent. Tattoos will be reported to the school safeguarding team



Shoes

Plain black – there should be no coloured logos or tags on shoes.

Flat Heeled – shoes should have a flat base so no heels or platforms.

Leather or leather look – shoes should be polish leather or patent leather all over.

Plain black boots can be worn under trousers.

No trainers, pumps, high heels or canvas shoes.

Converse shoes or boots are not acceptable footwear for school or for PE lessons.
